This talk will provide an IPMA-relevant update on bed bug and cockroach research conducted at Purdue. More specifically, it will provide an overview of recent findings on bed bug escape behavior during heat treatments and its impacts on their survivorship. In another segment of this talk the status of insecticide resistance in bed bugs and cockroaches will be discussed along with the methods PMPs can use to self-diagnose resistance issues. In the last section of this talk, research-based evidence for effectively utilizing essential oils for structural pest management will be discussed.
